Below are some guidelines, recommendations and requirements for vaccinations, Visas, Flights, and other logistics.

Medical

The CDC inoculation links for Kenya & Tanzania are the most updated suggestions. The best advice is to call your family physician and ask her/him to recommend vaccinations and medications. Please make an appointment with your physician soon to get started! Do not wait until the last minute!

Insurance

Passport & Visas

Your USA Passport must be current and valid. Expiration date on passport must be greater than 6 months at time of travel or you risk being denied entry in Kenya. NOTE: Please send us a photocopy of your USA Passport in case your passport is lost outside the USA and for other safety reasons.

We must obtain a Visa for both Kenya and Tanzania. This will greatly speed things up in-country.

Flight Recommendations

Flight options are varied and wide. Ultimately, it is your responsibility to secure your flight to and from Nairobi, AFRICA.

Use these dates and times to judge which flight to purchase:

- ⇒ YC2N Africa Ecotour **officially starts at noon on August 1, 2017 in Nairobi, AFRICA**, and **officially ends on noon on August 12, 2017 in Nairobi, AFRICA**.
- ⇒ If you need to arrive a day or two early and/or depart a day or two later than these dates, we can help you make lodging and transportation arrangements, but these costs are your responsibility because they are NOT part of the YC2N trip itinerary. NOTE: Eric and Darlene are planning on arriving at least a day early and staying 2 days after in the Bed & Breakfast we use Day 1-3 of our itinerary.

Flight recommendations:

Leaving New York city on 31st July and arrive in Nairobi on the 1st of August, leave Nairobi on the 12th of August \$1,396 on Turkish Airline.
