Raptors: Our Birds of Prey

Our Birds of Prey Program introduces our audience to the full spectrum of birds known as Raptors. Learn about Falcons, Hawks, Eagles, Owls, Accipiters, and Vultures, where they can be found, and what makes a Raptor a Raptor! Throughout the program we will bring out various LIVE Raptors...up to 4, so have your cameras ready! Also on hand will be a multitude of animal artifacts, such as feathers, skulls, bird bones, cough pellets, nest boxes, talons, and more.



Reptiles & Amphibians: Herpetology 101

Reptiles and Amphibians are an amazing group of animals often referred to as Herptiles. People that study reptiles and amphibians are called Herpetologists. So Herp 101 is all about what makes this group of animals SO endearing that millions of people have them as pets. You will learn about the different groups of reptiles and the different groups of amphibians, and the main differences between them. Since Herptiles live around the world, we will learn about geography, animal adaptations to different environments (desert vs. tropical), and highlight each animal's unique characteristics. There is a minimum of 5 LIVE Animals!!



The Family of Reptiles

Using a multimedia presentation, a table-full of animal and plant artifacts, and several LIVE Animals, we share our experiences of traveling and exploring in the jungles of Central and South America to you! We will immerse you in the Rainforest with our tantalizing tales, vivid video clips, and amazing artifacts (seed pods, skulls, spices, more!). Oh wait, we have more...LIVE Animals!!! As we learn about the forest layers, you will see and perhaps hold some of the LIVE Animals that reside there!



What Makes A Mammal A Mammal?

Mammals certainly hold a special place in the human heart, or else we wouldn't have cats and dogs living in our homes! Join us for this lively presentation as we explore the fascinating characteristics of Mammals, including whales, bats, raccoons, bears, cows, horses, and so many more. Wolves to Dogs: Mankind's Best Friend ([download flier](#))

This presentation introduces you to the exciting and secretive lives of wolves, wolf ecology and biology, the differences between a wolf and dog, and the theoretical process of how humans could have domesticated the dog, "Man's best friend." The audience will be able to see a live wolf's behavior first-hand on the stage, as well as see, touch and feel authentic wildlife artifacts relating to wolves and wolf biology. Finally, we end the hour-long presentation with 1-2 Therapy Dogs that are trained to work with children, and can be safely pet and handled.
